



Dr. Vincenzo Summa is Head of Chemistry at IRBM Science Park, Rome Area, Italy. His Specialties are Medicinal Chemistry, antivirals, organic chemistry, management. Dr. Vincenzo Summa has worked at IRBM, originally the Italian site of Merck Research Laboratories, since 1996. Over the course of his career, he has covered positions of increasing responsibility in the medicinal chemistry field and has been involved in the development of several preclinical development compounds. He currently serves as Vice-President of Drug Discovery, overseeing the IRBM drug discovery activities. Dr. Summa has been recognized by the American Chemical Society and inducted into its Heroes of Chemistry hall of fame twice, first in 2013, for his contribution to Raltegravir (ISENRESS®), a first-in-class HIV integrase inhibitor approved as first line therapy for the treatment of HIV positive patients; and in 2017, for Grazoprevir (ZEPATIER®). Dr. Summa earned his Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry from the Bergische Universität Wuppertal, Germany.
